Targets for Southwater Infant's Travel Plan

Target	Proposed Action
1. To achieve a target of 90% of children using sustainable forms of transport to and from school daily	Continued promotion of sustainable transport by linking to curriculum based activities throughout the year.
2. To research the feasibility of providing safety railings along the road side section of the pavement that runs between our school and the Junior School.	This has been discussed with the Parish Council and approved. We have applied to WSCC for funding and we are awaiting further response. (Dec 2010)
3. To monitor changes in levels of vehicle related pollution in and around the school grounds throughout the year.	Liaison with WSCC Road Safety Team and Horsham District Council Public Health Department.
